WW 2 Uniform Display at the October Monthly Meeting

Hello fellow hobbyists. At the last monthly meeting I inquired if anyone was interested in a presentation of authentic WW2 uniforms. The response was overall positive, so I have contacted my friend Paul Stanley (NOT a former member of KISS) to see if he would be willing to show off part of his personal collection. Luckily, Paul has agreed to bring some of his uniforms down to our next monthly meeting.

Paul has been collecting uniforms and hitting the military shows for the last 12 years or so. Initially, his interest was in German military uniforms, but he has branched out and now collects anything WW2. His collection and expertise has grown over the years and Paul has an impressive personal collection of authentic gear.

Paul will plan on bringing down an Afrika Corps tunic w/field gear, an U-boat dress jacket & hat as well as a German Mountain Troop uniform from the Italian campaign as well as other pieces for viewing. There will be other "goodies" on display and this should be pretty educational for all WW2 history buffs. Paul will also describe what he looks for at shows and what he looks for to determine a fake from the real deal.
